### Carlisle High School Indian Band

The Carlisle Indian Band is a family of musicians, who through diligent hard work make their community and school proud. The Carlisle Band was founded in 1934 by L. H. Buckner, former TMEA president, with the purpose of providing a musical outlet to its students and pride to its school and community.

At present, the Carlisle Band program consists of students in grades five through twelve. The middle school is split into beginner, intermediate, and middle school bands. Beginners are taught heterogeneously for 50 minutes every day. Every student in fifth grade is enrolled in beginner band, which averages 50 students each year. Students are taught sound fundamentals, paying particular attention to rhythmic unity and fundamental tone quality.

The Carlisle Intermediate Band is composed of sixth grade students and maintains an average enrollment of 50 students each year. These students perform two concerts each year as well as a recital at the end of the first semester designed to teach solo performance concepts. These students are given the chance to audition for the ATSSB Middle School All Region Band and are also required to learn and perform all twelve major scales, the chromatic scale, and exhibit UIL Level I sight reading skills by the end of the year.

The newly-formed Middle School Band is composed of thirty seventh-grade musicians and competes in both invitational, UIL, and ATSSB sponsored competitions. It is organized and taught by Ms. Amanda Smith. Each student in this ensemble is required to audition for All Region in the fall as well as perform a solo or ensemble in the spring semester.

The Carlisle Indian Band is currently composed of ninety-five members from eighth through twelfth grades. In 2012, the band earned its fifth consecutive UIL Sweepstakes Award. In the fall, the Indian Band performs in several marching events including invitational and U.I.L. marching competitions. Members of the ensemble participate in the ATSSB All State process in the fall as well as U.I.L. Solo and Ensemble Contest with many students advancing to the state level. In the 2011 ATSSB Outstanding Performance Series process, the Indian Band was selected as the state runner-up in the march category and the state winner in the concert selection. In 2012, the band was selected as the winner in the concert selection, with all three U.I.L. contest pieces competing at the state level. This is the Indian Band's fourth consecutive Honor Band Award, with the previous three being facilitated by former director Scott Rhame.

Mr. King is currently in his 7th year of teaching and 3rd at Carlisle ISD. He is a member of TMEA, ATSSB, the International Trombone Association, Pi Kappa Lambda, Kappa Kappa Psi, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia.

Mr. King began his career in 2006 at DeKalb ISD as the middle school director with Nicholas Durham and took over the Director of Bands position in 2008. While at DeKalb, Mr. King's bands received superior ratings and competed well in UIL as well as invitational marching contests. At Carlisle, Mr. King's bands have competed successfully in UIL events having retained Carlisle's 15th consecutive UIL Sweepstakes Award this past year. They have also been competitive in ATSSB's Outstanding Performance Series, 2nd in march and 1st in concert in 2011, and 1st in concert in 2012 with both other selections taking 4th place at the state level. Josh and his wife Michelle live in Henderson, Texas with their three-year-old twins Aaden and Noah.

#### Amanda Smith, Assistant Director

Ms. Smith is the Assistant Director at Carlisle ISD. She is a 2008 graduate of Weatherford High School, and received her Bachelor of Music Education from Stephen F. Austin State University in 2012, graduating summa cum laude. During her tenure at SFA, she was in the Wind Ensemble, Orchestra of the Pines, Lumberjack Marching Band, Choral Union, and Steel Band. Currently in her first year of teaching, Ms. Smith directs the seventh grade band and teaches beginning woodwinds. She is a member of Pi Kappa Lambda, TMEA, and ATSSB.

#### Harvey Durham, Guest Conductor

Born and raised in Paris, Texas, Mr. Durham began his musical studies under the tutelage and direction of Irene and Floyd Weger. Following his graduation from Paris High School, Mr. Durham earned a Bachelor of Music Education degree from East Texas State University in Commerce, Texas. His teaching career spands 33 years, beginning in 1976 at Ore City ISD, followed by Daingerfield in 1984, New Boston in 1985, Ennis in 1990, and finally to Longview ISD in 1994.

Following retirement from Longview ISD in 2009, Durham became a school representative for Tatum Music in Longview. This school year, he returned to teaching at Union Grove ISD were he serves as Director of Bands.
