Mr. Lindquist graduated Magna Cum Laude from the University of Miami (FL) with a Bachelor of Music Education in 1999. While in Miami, he served as Principal Trombone of both the University of Miami Symphony Orchestra and the University of Miami Wind Ensemble under the direction of maestro Gary Green. Jeremy studied applied trombone with both Hugh Harbison and Timothy Connor. He also studied brass pedagogy with Gilbert Johnson, for-mer Principal Trumpet in the Philadelphia Orchestra. While at Miami, Jeremy also studied Music Education courses with Dr. Richard Fiese, currently at Houston Baptist University. Mr. Lindquist attended Griffin Middle School in The Colony, Texas where he was under the direction of Ms. Kathy Johnson and Mr. John Benzer. Jeremy graduated from The Colony High School in 1995 where he performed in the Wind Symphony under the direction of Mr. Dick Clardy. About the Director

Joey Ashbrook is currently serving Coppell Middle School North in his 10th year as the Director of Bands. He began teaching in Coppell in 1992 as the assistant at CHS. He is a graduate of Stephen F. Austin State University studying under Mel Montgomery and John Whitwell. Two year Drum Major for the S.F.A. Lumberjack Marching Band, Ashbrook was consistently named to the University Dean's list graduating in 1988. Ashbrook was a four year member of the S.F.A. Wind Ensemble, the Honors Saxophone Quartet, Treasurer for Kappa Kappa Psi and Graduate Assistant in the fall of 1988 under John Whitwell and Dr. Steve Peterson. Ashbrook studied Saxophone and Double Reeds with Dr. John Goodall. Mas-ters of Music degree was completed with honors at Eastern New Mexico University under Dr. David Eisler. Ashbrook began his teaching career as director for Colorado City Middle School Bands before moving to become the assistant Director of Bands for Crane I.S.D. While in Crane, Scott Mason and Joey Ashbrook were fortunate to have the 3-A State Honor Band in 1990, the Runner-up State Champion Marching Band, the Outstanding Sweepstakes Award for the state solo competition, and the Outstanding Wind Ensemble for the State of Texas. Moving to Sundown, Tx., Ashbrook assisted the Sundown band program under Mr. Barry Hurt, who was also Ashbrook's HS band director in Henrietta, Tx. Barry Hurt and Joey Ashbrook had great success with the Sundown bands placing 2nd in the State Marching Band Competition two times, receiving con-sistent sweepstakes awards for the HS 1st & 2nd bands and MS Bands, and performed for the National Fourth of July Inde-pendence Day Parade in Washington D.C., featured in concert at the base of the Statue of Liberty.

Ashbrook moved to Coppell in 1992 as the assistant director for Coppell High School under Mr. Scott Mason. Under the leadership of Mason and Ashbrook, the Coppell High School Band grew from 120 members to over 350 hundred strong breaking many regional, state and national records for individual and full band competitions. The Coppell High School Band was selected as the TMEA State Honor Band in 1997 and consistently ranked in the top 5 marching bands in the state of Texas. Coppell won the State Champion Marching Band Award in 1998 and was named as the Best Band Program in the Country. Coppell has been fortunate to have the most students selected to the Texas All-State groups in the past 10 years than any band, choir or orchestra. For the past 10 years, Ashbrook has been the Director of Bands at Coppell Middle School North where the North Band Program has grown in size from 150 members to over 340 students today. The award winning North Band has become known locally, state-wide and nationally as a very successful and high quality performing group presenting very demanding and advanced musical literature. For the past 12 years, the North band has received consecutive sweepstakes awards and overall outstanding band selec-tion at various local and state festivals. North students received 297 first division solo awards with 8 outstanding soloists, unanimous superior ratings at all competitions for the North Bands, first place winner at several competitions including three time selection as the overall outstanding band at the Dallas Wind Symphony Invitational competition held at the Meyerson. The band was the T.M.E.A. State Honor Band in 2006-2007 and 1st runner-up in 2009. North has also been chosen as a national win-ner by the Mark of Excellence program through the Foundation for Music Education. The North Band is continuing their tradition of excellence with an extremely strong beginner band program averaging 150-170 members each year. He is in charge
